Q: Configuring MySQL User with identical privileges on a per database basis This is for a dockerized mysql instance running on EC2. I have several databases, each with a different set of privileges that my app needs access to. Each database has its own different set of users, with their own set of privileges. When I grant privileges to a user on the 'default' database (the one set up during installation), it can read/write to the database on all the others, as long as it has the appropriate privileges. The problem is that there are a lot of users to grant, and it seems a little inefficient to keep granting their privileges on each database on a case-by-case basis. It's also not an option to keep the default schema in its own database, as this would require granting privileges to the global schema on each database individually, which defeats the purpose. Is there any way I can create the default user and grant it a single set of privileges on all the databases, but without compromising security? A: Grants are not database-specific - they are application-level. Let's say you have DB1, DB2 and DB3. To grant privileges on DB1, DB2 and DB3 you need to use an application-level GRANT statement. In other words - I don't see a way to create a GRANT statement that is database-specific.
